

Registration swisscovery (SLSP) without SWITCH edu-ID

Don't you have a SWITCH edu-IDi yet and you are a (new) library customer and **not** a member of staff or a student at a CH university?

Then register with swisscovery (SLSP) using the following instructions.

Side note: HSLU und PHLU → Are you

- a student/faculty member at the Lucerne University of Applied Sciences and Arts (HSLU)?
- b) a student at the Lucerne University of Teacher Education (PH Luzern)?

Please finish the Onboarding process of your university first, where your SWITCH edu-ID automatically will be linked to your Organisational Identity:

After completing the onboarding process, continue the registration with these instructions.

1. Go to the registration platform https://registration.slsp.ch/?iz=rzs/?lang=en and start the registration:

swisscovery Registration

To login to swisscovery and access library content, you need a Switch edu-ID account with which you can register with SLSP. The required steps are:

- 1. Click on 'Start Registration'
 - You will be redirected to the edu-ID login page.
- 2. Log in with an edu-ID account
 - If you don't have an edu-ID account yet, please create one.
- 3. Accept the terms of use and finish the registration

Optionally provide the number of your library card if you have one.




Manage library cards and settings (such as different invoice address)







1. Click on "Create account":










2. Add the required data:

- a) Fill in the mandatory information: required = mandatory; conditionally required = at least one of these is required, e.g. EITHER the private phone number OR the mobile phone number
- b) Chose a password.
- c) Accept the terms of use from SWITCH.

3. Verify your e-mail address with the sent code:




The confirmation of the e-mail address is accepted, and the SWITCH edu-ID is now active.

4. Verify your mobile number (in case you added it) with the sent code:

If possible, also verify your mobile number and click on "Continue". If you do not receive the code within a few minutes, continue with "Continue to the Swisscovery registration service".

5. Go back to the registration platform https://registration.slsp.ch/?iz=rzs/?lang=en

Login with the e-mail address and the password deposited in your newly created SWITCH edu-ID:










6. Agree the disclosure of data for SLSP (Swiss Library Service Platform):

The swisscovery search portal (a service provided by SLSP) cannot be accessed without the consent.










2. Finish the registration:

a) Add your library card number.

If you don't have a card yet, you can get one at the information desk of one of our RZS libraries free of charge, the registration can be finished without a library card. A campus card of the HSLU, University of Lucerne and the Universities of Teacher Education Lucerne, Schwyz, and Zug as well as from most other Swiss universities can be used as a library card even after you graduated.

b) Read and accept the terms of use and click on «Register»

The registration is now done.









i GLOSSARY:

- Swisscovery / SLSP: The Swiss Library Service Platform is a service provider for libraries and collaborates with them to run the national library platform swisscovery. The swisscovery platform brings together scientific resources from a current total of 500 libraries in Switzerland, making information easily accessible and simple to find. On behalf of the libraries, SLSP invoices services provided by the libraries to swisscovery users.
- SWITCH: SWITCH is a trustworthy non-profit organisation founded by the Swiss government and the university cantons.
- SWITCH edu-ID: One identity for all services in the Swiss university environment, regardless of the organization, valid for life.
- Linked Identities / Organisational Identity: Is an authentication procedure administered by the SWITCH Foundation and used by all universities and universities of applied sciences in Switzerland, offering access to various services.
